*We keep a time of silent preparation and then  
STAND when the Bell rings for the Entrance  
Litany.*

Let us proceed in peace:

**+ In the Name of Christ. Amen**

*The Priest declares Absolution, which we receive  
with the Sign of the Cross and say Amen.*

**Glory to God in the highest  
And on earth peace to people of goodwill.**

**We praise You, we bless You,  
we adore You, we glorify You.**

**We give you thanks for Your great glory.**

**Lord God, Heavenly King,  
Almighty God and Father -**

**Lord Jesus Christ,  
only-begotten Son**

**Lord God, Lamb of God**

**Son of the Father**

**You take away the sins of the world**

**Have mercy on us**

**Receive our prayer;**

**You are seated**

**at the right hand of the Father**

## **THE LITURGY OF THE WORD**

*A reading follows, then the Psalm.*

*After a pause, we STAND to prepare to hear the Gospel:*

The Lord be with you:  
**And with your spirit**

*When the Gospel is announced:*  
**+ Glory to you, O Lord**

*After the Gospel:*  
This is the Gospel of the Lord:  
**Praise to you, O Christ.**

*WE SIT for the Homily, followed by a time of reflection as music is played.*

*We STAND to declare our Faith:*  
**We believe in one God,  
the Father almighty,  
maker of heaven and earth,  
and of all that is, seen and unseen.  
We believe in one Lord Jesus Christ,  
the Only-Begotten Son of God,  
born of the Father before all worlds.  
God from God, Light from Light,  
true God from true God,  
begotten, not made,  
Of One Being with the Father;  
through him all things were made.  
For us and for our salvation  
he came down from heaven,  
and was incarnate by the Holy Spirit  
and the Virgin Mary,  
and became man.  
For our sake he was crucified  
under Pontius Pilate;  
he suffered death and was buried.  
On the third day he rose again  
in accordance with the Scriptures;  
he ascended into heaven and is seated  
at the right hand of the Father.  
He will come again in glory  
to judge the living and the dead,  
and his kingdom will have no end.**

**We believe in the Holy Spirit,  
the Lord, the giver of life,  
who proceeds from the Father  
(and the Son).  
With the Father and the Son  
he is worshipped and glorified.  
He has spoken through the Prophets.  
We believe in one holy catholic  
and apostolic Church.  
We acknowledge one baptism  
for the forgiveness of sins.  
We look for the resurrection of the dead,  
and the life of the world to come. Amen**
